

## **AWARDS PROGRAM**

### **Purpose:**

- To set forth a standardized guideline related to the various awards given to members at the annual banquet.

### **Guideline:**

#### **Firefighter of the Year**

- Must be an active member in good standing for the entire year
- Must be moving forward with their firefighting skills
- Attends Alarms, Drills, and Meetings regularly
- Must have completed FF1 or Fire Scene Support Ops
- Shows a willingness to help other firefighters when needed
- Must show a positive attitude towards the SVFD and its membership

Member will receive a take home award as well as a Leather New Yorker Helmet or a set of leather boots if requested

#### **Rookie of the Year**

- Must be an active member in good standing with less than 20 months in the department.
- Must be moving forward in their firefighting skills
- Attends Alarms, Drills, and Meetings regularly
- Shows a willingness to learn new skills

Member will receive a take home award and a jacket with department logo

#### **Alarm Responses**

- These awards are given for the total number of alarms responded to
  - 100 – 199 = Certificate and Award
  - 200 – 299 = Certificate and Award
  - 300 – 399 = Certificate and Award
  - 400 and up = Certificate and Award
    - Most EMS Alarms – Leatherman Tool
    - Most Fire Alarms – Leatherman Tool

Awards will be determined by the Chief and President prior to the banquet

#### **Training Awards**

- Overall Training for the Year
  - Highest number of training hours for the year includes all Scriba FD training, State and County Training including EMS.
    - Department Work Shirt
- Scriba Fire Dept Training
  - Includes scheduled Tuesday night drills. Saturday drills and any make-up or extra drills
    - Department Work Shirt
