

TRAINING GUIDELINE:

PURPOSE:

- To establish a guideline that allows all personnel to understand the Scriba Fire Departments Training Program, its requirements and actions when necessary requirements are not met.

GUIDELINE

- All members are required to attend a minimum of twelve (12) two hour drills as outlined in the department bylaws. This is the minimum requirement to be maintained as an active member.
- Drills are run on the first, second, and third Tuesdays of every month and start at 7pm and may run as late as 10pm depending on the subject matter
- An additional drill will be run on either a Saturday or Sunday each month
- Extra Drills will be posted as structures, seminars, or training becomes available

Drill Credit

- Drill credit will be issued for every drill attended and participated in.
- Drill credit will be allowed for personnel that attend classes on a drill night (Tuesday) or two nights a week. (This can be fire or ems)
- Drill credit will be awarded for attending an all day seminar (EMS or Fire)
- EMTS can receive up to 4 drill credits for attending EMS classes that award core content hours. In order to receive credit member must turn in the pilot hours form signed by the instructor.
- Members that are compensated firefighters can receive up to 8 drill credits by turning in their training record from work.

REQUIREMENTS

- Infection Control / Firefighter Safety - Required for all active firefighters without exception
 - This training will be held in January and members not completing the training by the end of January will be suspended from responding to alarms until the training is completed
- Hazardous Materials Awareness – Required for all active firefighters without exception
 - Training will be held in December and must be completed by the end of December, Members not completing the training will be suspended from responding to alarms until training is completed
- Respiratory Protection / SCBA – Required for all interior firefighters and trainees
 - Classroom Training will be held in February
 - Hands on training in March and April
 - Members not completing the training by the end of April will be suspended from SCBA usage until requirements are met

- Driver/Operator – Required for current operators and trainees
 - Must attend classroom training and EVOC course held in May
 - If not completed by the end of May member is suspended from driver/operator until completed

*** Any member suspended from operations under this guideline must see 2702 to get reinstated without exception

TRAINING SEMINARS / CLASSES

- It is the policy of the Chief's Office to send as many members as possible to outside training as the budget can allow.
- As normally occurs there a few members taking many courses and each course and member will be approved by the Training Officer if there is a conflict that cannot be resolved the Chief will make the final determination
