

FIRE APPARATUS DRIVER / OPERATOR REQUALIFICATION GUIDELINE

PURPOSE:

- To establish a uniform guideline for the yearly re-qualification of driver / operators in the Scriba Volunteer Fire Department.

GUIDELINE:

- May is the designated month for Operator Requalification
- Requirements to be re-qualified as a Driver/Operator are:
 - Current Valid New York State Drivers License
 - Approved by the Insurance Carrier
 - Successfully complete the pylon course
 - Successfully complete the pump operations checklist.
 - Completed department requirements and be approved by the Chief
- Pylon Course will involve the following skills.
 - Straight Line Driving
 - Alley Dock
 - Serpentine Exercise
 - Diminished Clearance
- Pump operators must successfully complete a pump operations check off sheet for each engine they are qualified on without assistance from the evaluator.
 - On the Job evaluations may be completed for members that have operated the apparatus at working fires.
- Evaluators will be appointed by the Chief's Office
- Any member that does not operate apparatus or attend drills for more than four months will be required to re-qualify upon their return to duty before being allowed to operate apparatus.
