

EMERGENCY VEHICLE OPERATIONS –Parade Practices

PURPOSE:

- To establish a standard for members of the Scriba Vol. Fire Dept. related to the use, operation, passengers, while attending a parade.

GUIDELINE:

- In-Service apparatus will only be allowed to attend a parade outside the Town of Scriba after approval of the Fire Chief.
- Only qualified apparatus operators will operate the apparatus.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the apparatus, members manning the apparatus are not allowed alcoholic beverages.
- Family members are allowed to ride the apparatus as long as they are not taking a seat from an active member.
 - If there is not room or the child needs a car seat for safety the family members may meet the apparatus at the parade and ride.
- Riders are allowed on the pump panel, rear step, and hose bed as long as a member is assigned to the rear step to prevent falls
 - NO STANDING IN HOSE BED
- Apparatus will Not be operated over 10mph with riders on apparatus
- Any member or family member that appears under the influence will not ride the apparatus other than in a seat belted position with the truck officers approval
- Apparatus will be returned to service along with any equipment used by the crew prior to going home.
- Do not call 911 on the radio to report the apparatus out of service
